



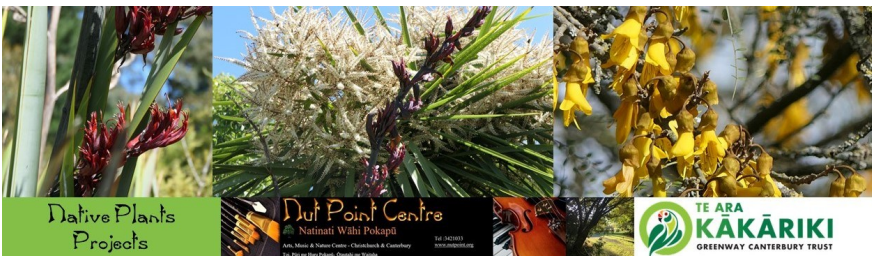

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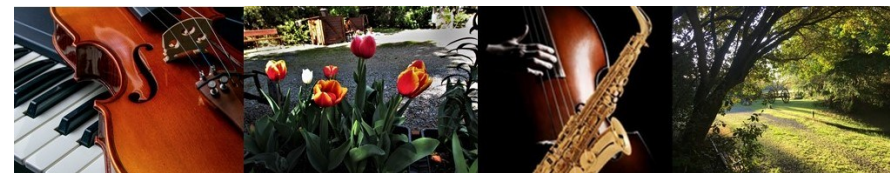

For Christchurch pianist *Anna Maksymova*, music is her passion. In demand as a performer and a piano teacher, she has a busy schedule juggling concert life and full time teaching.

Anna was born in Ukraine and came to New Zealand in 2002 with her musician parents. The family quickly established themselves in the local and national music scene.

As a child Anna attended Donetsk Music School for gifted children and was involved in the Special Music Programme at Burnside High School in Christchurch. She later completed Bachelor of Music Degree with First-Class Honours under the tutelage of Professor Michael Endres at the University of Canterbury. During this time she was placed 3rd in the Kerikeri International Competition and won numerous scholarships. Further studies took her to the Frankfurt Hochschule für Musik, completing Masters of Music in piano performance in the class of renowned Russian pianist and teacher Lev Natochenny.

Since her return from overseas in 2016 she has been involved as a soloist with the Christchurch Symphony Orchestra, Akaroa Summer School and Dame Malvina Major Foundation. She performs regularly at the Great Hall and the Piano. A recent highlight was her solo concert as a part of the series Sundays at 4 dedicated to presenting foremost New Zealand pianists.

As a collaborative pianist, Anna has been involved with the Baroque Music Trust since 2018 in their series Travel Thru Time, resulting in several concert tours around the South Island. Anna's stage partners have included well known New Zealand musicians like Mark Walton, Mark Menzies, Juliet Reynolds-Midgley, Wade Kernot, Tomas Hurnik, Anna Hoetjes, Oliver Sewell among others. Recent collaborations included star opera singers Anna Leese and Paul Whelan.

Alongside professional engagements Anna volunteers playing the piano at the Christchurch Burwood Hospital. In her spare time she enjoys arts and crafts, travelling, exploring the outdoors and spending time with her family.
