In memory of Richard Chandler RIP

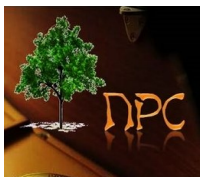
Richard Chandler, member of the CSO family, Associate Principal Bassoon and an accomplished pianist,
